

M.O.F.S.C. Wednesday's Twilight Sailing Instructions - 2018

Open to all sailing yachts that meet the required D.o.T. requirements

- Course:** Iconic Peninsula Fig Start, A, D, A, Fishing Platform Finish. Leave A and D marks to Starboard.
- Start:** In a North Westerly direction using the start line between the Peninsula Fig and the Southern bank of the Port Mandurah Canals, as shown on the attached chart.
- Finish:** In a South Easterly direction square with the Northern most end of the Fishing Platform.
- Start Time:** **18:00** (We ask everyone not to start before 18:00 please as the group start creates a great spectacle for our event)

The point may, or may not, be personed with a Flag Waver to assist with the start, so if not, enjoy the intended spirit of the event and use your mobile phone time.

If time permits, a sail up the estuary to near the Red Manna Restaurant before heading back to the club is a superb way to finish your sail.

Bring along your food and join in the BBQ and social get together on the raised alfresco area outside the Dolphin View Room straight after the event!

Please be aware that on Wednesday evenings the Club Bar is now open for drinks.

*We almost got it but sadly due to not being able to secure the Sheep Station, these events are designed as **Fun events for all.***

Rule: *Although the racing rules are to be followed in this event, please be mindful of other boats or skippers who may require you give them more time and room around the course, due to either being quite new to the rules of sailing, shorthanded or have extra people, animals or champagne on board.*

Anyone not adhering to this rule will be asked to explain themselves at the get together immediately after the event!

Safety: *Although Fun is the overall focus of these events, safety must never be compromised! Always have a competent helmsperson near the helm at all times!*

Radio: *Also for safety please remain on **VHF channel 72** during the Twilight Events, and keep an ear out for anyone (especially in our fleet) who may require assistance. We always look out for each other!*
